
Why do dogs bark?

- Play






What can be done?



- O Increase exercise
- O Increase mental enrichment
 - food dispensing toys
- Increase management strategies



What can be done?



• Increase exercise

- Longer walks every day to help tire the dog out
- O Increase mental enrichment (food dispensing toys)
- O Increase management strategies



A tired dog is a good dog



OBut is it?

What happens when you increase exercise?



Is all exercise equal?



- Walks on lead
- Walks off lead
- OPlay with dogs
- Fetch
- Sniffari

Can you change it up?

Do you have to leave the house?



Play at home?



Suggest realistic changes



- Try to make recommendations that the owner can achieve
 - Varied types of exercise
 - 2 walks are better than 1
 - Better walking equipment?

What about the quick fix?



- OCitronella, ultrasonic, vibration and electric shock collars
- O Hushers
 - May stop barking, but don't provide an alternative
 - Habituation to the device (Wells, 2001)
 - Other problem behaviours arise
 - Punishment methods are a welfare concern (Beerda et al, 1997; Schilder & van der Borg, 2003; Ziv, 2017)
 - Not endorsed by RSPCA SA
